THE ORGAN

St Mary's Church dates from the twelfth century and boasts a magnificent fifteenth-century tower. The organ was built in 1870 by T.C. Lewis; it is placed on the north side of the chancel and remains unaltered. It was restored by Harrison & Harrison in 2016.
